



## LAMINATE

**About:** Laminate is a highly durable material which requires minimal maintenance. It should be cleaned regularly, but no special treatment is required. However, it will discolour if surfaces are left unattended after spills from juice, colourful drinks, or harsh chemicals.

**Daily cleaning:**

Wipe it down with a damp cloth that has been wrung in warm water. For harsh stains that do not disappear with regular cleaning, use a melamine sponge which is either dry or slightly moistened.

**General maintenance:**

Wipe the surfaces daily with a cloth that has been wrung in lukewarm water, or lukewarm water containing a mild all- purpose cleaning agent, and then wipe with a dry cloth. Any liquid spills that have staining potential, such as red wine or coffee, must be wiped immediately to avoid discolourations. Remove tough stains or dirt by adding more cleaning agents and using a soft sponge, then finishing with a dry cloth.

**Important: Avoid rubbing the surface too harsh. Instead, dab with a cloth. Avoid excessive wetting and harsh abrasion, since it can ruin the fabric. Cleaning textile surface and fabrics regularly can also loosen the fibres over time.**
